It's that time again! The coming year subscriptions are due by Thursday 15th January. The fees for the year are detailed below with some worked examples to help. There is what we trust will be a welcome decrease in fees arising from an end of year surplus.

Your prompt payment would be appreciated and a discount is given for this. ***Let me know if you or your child no longer wish to continue membership as we would like to offer places to those on the substantial waiting list as soon as possible.*** After the 15th January discounts do not apply, places are not secure and may be offered to those waiting.

Attached is the code of conduct our coaches require swimmers to adhere to. Please help your child to arrive on time and meet the other conditions described. DISCOUNTS

- ✓ £20 discount for any member paying the full year's fees by 15th January (fees made up of membership amount plus the 3 termly fees).
- ✓ £20 membership discount for each subsequent family member (family members have to be resident at same address).

There are some worked examples on the membership form to avoid any confusion for families with multiple swimmers.

Worked examples

a) One family has 2 junior swimmers and pays the year's fees by the 15th January.

First membership £60, Second £40 – total membership	£100
One junior's year's termly fees £30 x 3, - £20 for paying full year	£ 70
Second juniors termly fees are the same as first	£ 70
Total	£240

(if the family chose to pay termly and missed 15th January deadline total £280)

b) Another family has a master and a junior and pays for the first term by the 15th

First membership £60, second £40	£100
One junior fees £30, one master £60	£ 90
January Total	£190
Followed by x2 additional termly fees of £90	£180
Annual Total	£370

c) The same family decide to pay the full amount by the 15th

First membership £60, second £40	£100
One junior's year's fees £30 x 3 - £20	£ 70
One masters fees for year £60 x 3 - £20	£160
Total	£330
